
TIMELINE OF ABRAHAMIC RELIGIONS


















ISLAM: Size of Religion

Islam FOUNDER



- Muhammad (Mohammed) is the founder of Islam.
- He claims to be the **final prophet**, or messenger, of God.
- Abraham is considered the father of the Muslim people.

HOLY BOOK/SACRED TEXT



Qu'ran (Koran)

- Muslims see it as the final & complete word of God
- contains much of the <u>Old Testament</u> (Judaism) and the <u>New Testament</u> (Christianity).

- NOT the son of God




BASIC BELIEFS:

Five pillars of Faith – guidelines for Muslims

- <u>Shahada</u> belief in <u>one</u>
 <u>God</u>, Muhammad is his prophet
- 2. <u>Salat</u> <u>pray 5 times</u> daily towards Mecca
- 3. <u>Zakat</u> giving of <u>charity</u>
- 4. <u>Sawan</u> <u>fasting</u> during the holy month of Ramadan

5. <u>Hajj</u> - <u>pilgrimage</u> to the city of Mecca,
the birthplace of Muhammed




IM PORTANT PLACES <u>BUIDLING</u>



Mosques are the buildings in which Muslims worship.







IMPORTANT PLACES <u>CITIES</u>



- 1. Mecca (Saudi Arabia)
 - Muhammad's birth
 - Ka'aba
- 2. Medina (Saudi Arabia)
 - where Muhammad and his followers fled during the *Hijrah*.
- 3. Jerusalem (Israel)
 - Dome of the Rock
 - where Muhammad made a night journey to heaven

What about these required prayers?

The mandatory prayers performed 5 times a day:

- * dawn
- * noon
- * late afternoon
- * sunset
- before going to bed

Face Mecca and use a prayer rug.







Don't get confused!

- All 3 Middle Eastern Religions are monotheistic
- Christians believe in god as a <u>trinity</u> (father, son, holy spirit) and that Jesus was god's *son*
- Muslims believe that Muhammed was god's messenger (not son)
- All 3 share the same foundation through the lineage of <u>Abraham</u>
