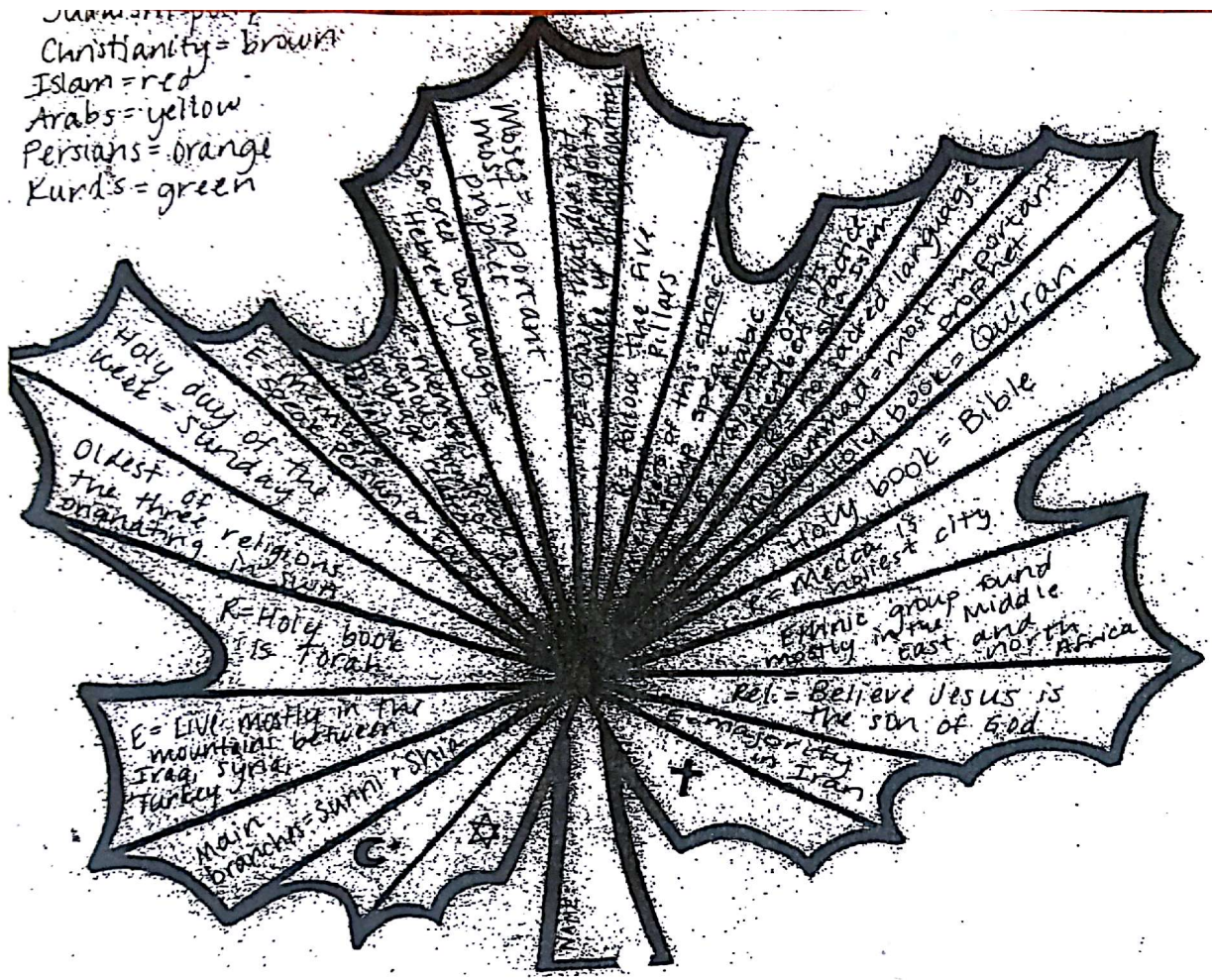


Christianity = brown
